- To outsource the job related to documentation like report for generation, transportation and disposal of BMW, annual report etc, required as per the statutory government guidelines through appropriate consultancy farm.
- To recruit staffs and officers immediately for supervision of day-to-day activities related to BMW and sanitation.

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- 8. To invite following person/ vendor in the next meeting in order to finalize the requirement of equipment and services for BMW related activities and to estimate the financial involvement -
 - · The manufacture of the BMW related equipment
 - · The service provider for collection and transportation of BMW
 - The consultant for documentation

The committee visited the BMW building which is being constructed temporary storage of BMW generated and collected from different corners/departments before disposal of the same. Considering the present site condition, the committee expressed serious concern over the progress of the work as the building must be ready before functioning of OPD.
